Notes:

1. Colors are not specific. Only used for your viewing ease.
2. The start and end of the bar is an average day within those months. Not an exact day.
3. The thickness of the bar indicates frequency or abundance of that species. The thinner the bar the less records and occurrence of the species. Peaks for these species are not document as more data are needed
4. A single DOT means there is only one record for that species in the county and may be a historical date with no further information.
5. This information is gathered from the personal logs of Jason Avery, photos from iNaturalist, records from Odonata Central, and records from Richard Orr.
