

























## Bug Cards

These can be used as bingo balls for [Insect Bingo](#) or if you print two copies as cards for the game Memory. It is recommended that the cards are put onto poster board and cut out. There are 22 insects plus three other 'bugs'.

Note the last two cards are alternates to be used in place of other cards above.

Ladybird is the British English equivalent for ladybug.

Shield bug is an alternative name for stinkbug. It gets the name stinkbug because it has glands that produce a putrid smell. It's also called a shield bug because it looks like a shield.
